### Grooming Release and Hold Harmless Agreement

CoPAW Cabana and CoPaw Cabana employees will be known from here on as CC. Your animal is very important to CC. CC will make every effort to assure that your animal's grooming experience is as safe and pleasant as possible. As always at the CC, safety comes first for everyone, people as well as the animals, during the entire stay at CC.

#### **Current Vaccinations**

Animals MUST be current on all vaccinations to enter CC, for any service. Proof of vaccinations from your veterinarian will be required, before grooming appointment is filled. Animals that are not current with vaccinations may be refused at CC. If special circumstances occur, please let us know and we can take a look into the situation, and make a decision.

#### **Muzzles**

CC may need to use a muzzle on your animal during the grooming process. Muzzles provide protection to the groomer, and the animal without harming the animal. You will be notified by CC if your animal requires the wearing of a muzzle during the grooming appointment. In most cases, the muzzle may calm the animal and allow the grooming process to continue. If for some reason, the animal is still hard to control and is creating a dangerous environment, CC has the right to stop the grooming.

#### **Refusal of Services**

CC has the right, for any reason to refuse, cancel or stop and grooming service at any time. CC will not groom and animal that is sedated, even though some animals cannot be groomed without being sedated. CC will contact the owner and have them picked up.

#### **Health/ Medical**

In the event your animal should require veterinarian assistance, CC will have permission to take your animal to your preferred veterinarian, or nearest available. Upon signing this agreement, all medical expenses for the veterinarian care of the animal, is to be covered by the animal's owner.

**Veterinarian release**

If an accident occurs durring the grooming process, (cut, clipper burn, sctratch,ect.), this agreement will give CC full authorization to act accordingly. Depending on the injury, CC will seek medical treatment from authorized veterinarian or nearest veterinarian. All veterinarian cost will be covered by animal’s owner.

**Matted Animal Procedure**

For the health of your animal, most severely mated will be shaven down. CC will notift you if it is necessary to shave part of, or your animals entire coat. If you can not be reacged, CC will make a decision based on trying to improve the health of your animal.

**Skin Conditions/ Flea Protection**

It is important to keep up with the grooming of your animal. If you don’t, sometimes the skin underheavily matted areas on the animal may be sensitive or may become sensitive. This may causethe skin to crack or bleed. In some cases, the skin can become infected.

Parasites may also be found under the heavy mats. CC may require you to give the animal an oral tropicel flea treatment before we groom the animal,to get rid of the parasites, a special shampoo can be used. CC recomends that the animal’s enviroment. Flea treatment is a requirement at CC, for the months of April, May, June, July, August, September and October. These are the months that are common for parasites.

**Bite Policy**

As the owner, caretaker or responsible party of the animal, it is your responsibility to disclose CC if your animal is a biter. If the animal bites anyone while at the CC, you (the owners owner, caretakeror responsible party) will be responsiblefor any and all medical expenses. CC will make every effort to provide a sefe enviroment for all involved.

**General**

For the safety of the animal’s, CC will require that all owner’s, caretakers or responsible parties, stay out of the grooming room durring the grooming process. The animal may become excited and move while being groomed, causing injury to the dog or the groomer. CC will make every effort to keep alll involved as safe as possible, at all times.
